- **Jan Sandler** was a guest of **Greg Marinucci**.

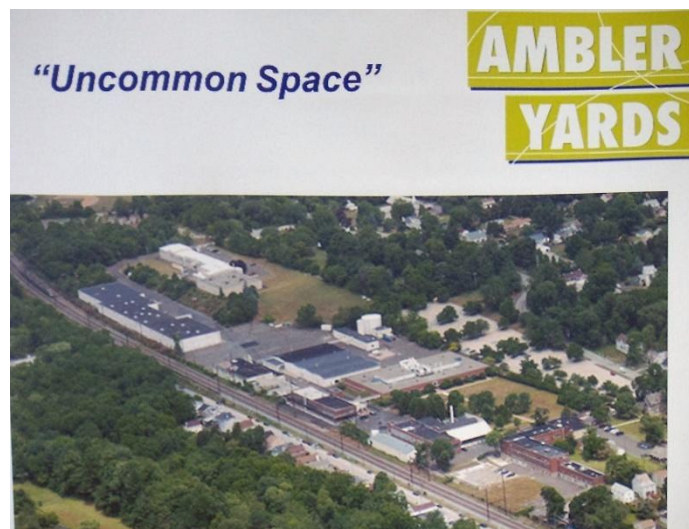
COMMUNITY IN CELEBRATION (a.k.a. HAPPY DOLLARS:
