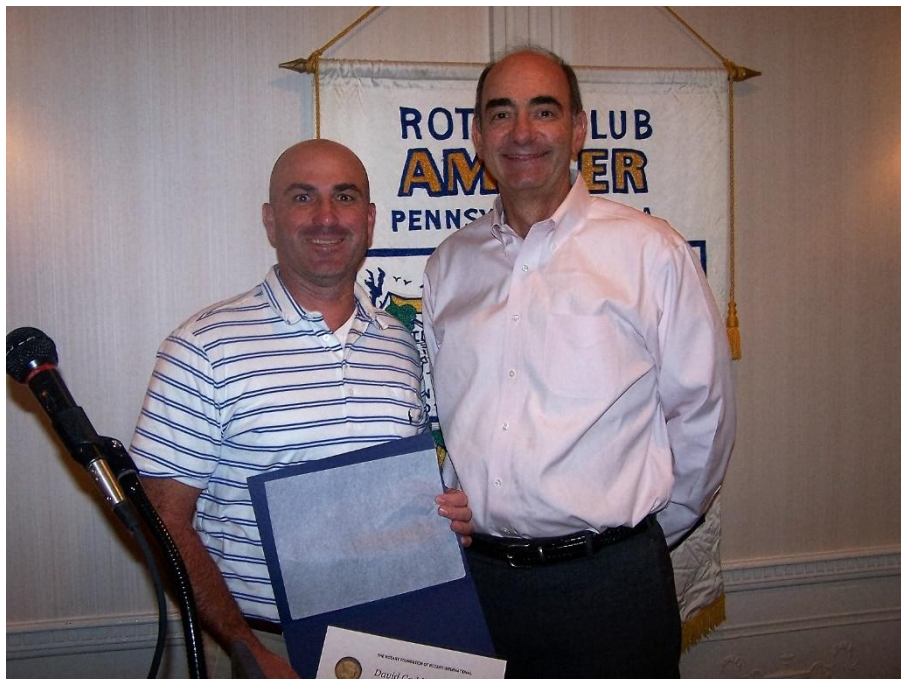

Every now and then, someone other than a club member contributes so much to our Club and the community that we honor them with an Honorary PHF. Today we honored **David Caddick II.**

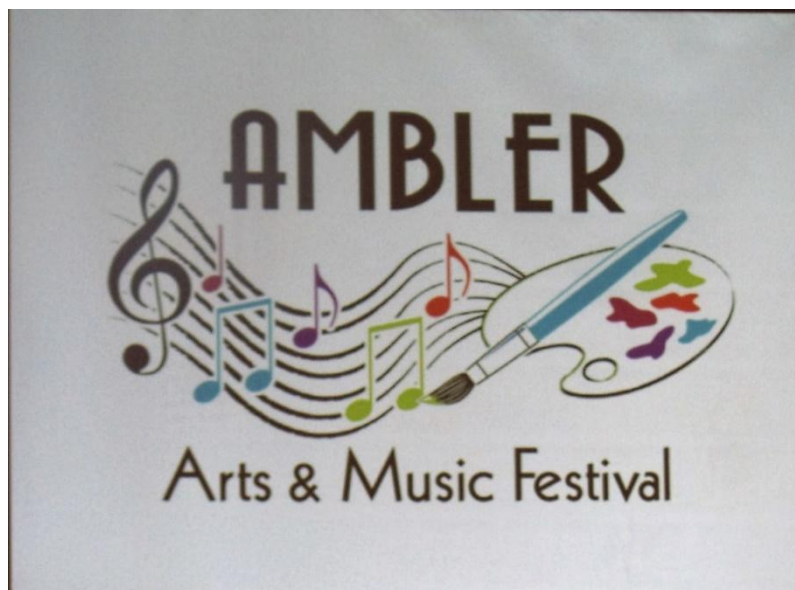


Here's an overview how David and his company help us:

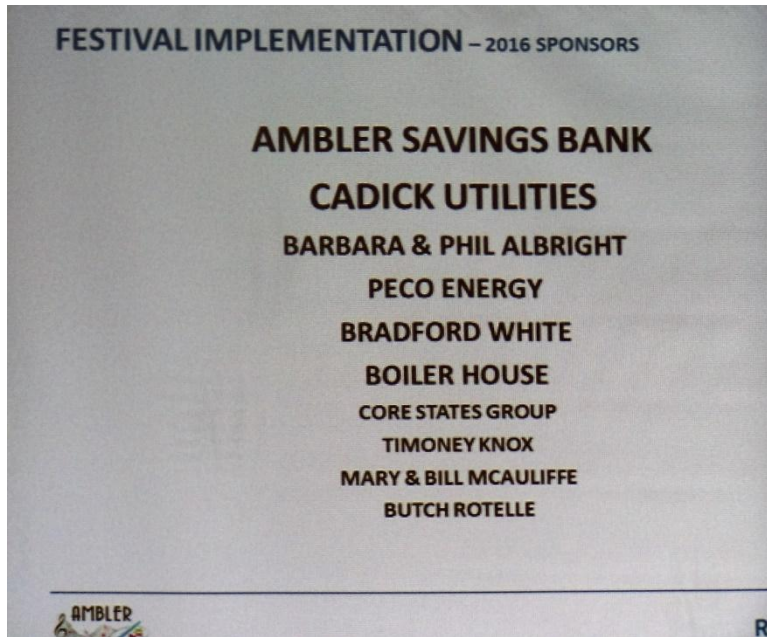
- Fabricated the custom trailer for Santa's Sleigh for the Ambler Holiday parade

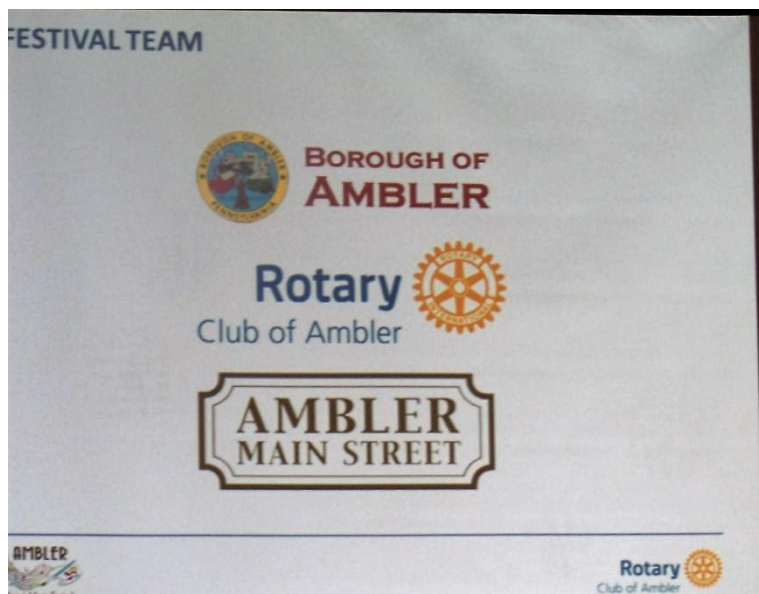


Gross income last year was around \$60,000 with net proceeds of \$25,000 each going to the Rotary Club of Ambler and Ambler Main Street.
